Keynotes

- **Don't Lose You, While Caring for Someone You Love**

Caregiving often becomes all-consuming, quietly reshaping our identity. This powerful keynote explores how to stay connected to your true self while meeting the needs of a loved one. With honesty and grace, Dr. Taylor shares how caregivers can maintain their voice, values, and vitality amidst long-term care.

- **Grieving While They're Still Here**

Caring for someone with a chronic illness or cognitive decline often involves ambiguous grief—the slow, quiet mourning of a person still physically present. This session creates space to name and honor that grief, while offering healing insights to carry caregivers through the long goodbye.

- **Reclaiming Joy: The Courage to Live After Loss**

After caregiving ends, many find themselves wandering emotionally. This talk explores the rediscovery of joy, purpose, and personal identity following loss. It's a message of renewal, built on the idea that healing is not forgetting—it's remembering yourself, too.

This interactive session offers practical, guilt-free self-care strategies that support emotional, mental, and physical well-being.
